

Catfish Stew Cookoff

Rules

Competitors will be required to cook their stew entirely at Hatcher Park in Lilesville beginning at noon. Judging will be held from 2 to 4 p.m., as individual stews are ready. Judging will be based on flavor, authenticity and appearance.

Each cook-off team will be responsible for its own supplies and means of cooking. Any number of people can be on a team. All entries must include a recipe, with the winning recipe to be published in local and regional newspapers after the cook-off.

First-place overall winner will receive \$250.00 and a Championship plaque. There will also be a \$25 cash prize for best "white" catfish stew and best "red" catfish stew.

Competitors are responsible for tidiness of their area!!
